





AND NOW... A FEW THINGS YOU MAY NEVER WANTED TO KNOW

The name Frank means 'free man'

Both of Frank's grandfathers are named Francis, yet his father is strangely named Franklin. Two of the three prefer to be called Frank and one prefers to be referred to as Larry. It's all a bit confusing.

Some inconclusive evidence shows that Frank could very well be a distant relative to a noteworthy seafarer.

Captain George Shelvocke (1675–1742) was an English privateer who wrote a famous book based on his exploits, *A Voyage Round the World By Way of The Great South Sea*, published in 1723.

An episode in this book supposedly served to inspire the central image of Samuel Taylor Coleridge's poem, *The Rime of the Ancient Mariner*. At one point in his career Shelvocke was arrested in England on charges of piracy, though he was quickly acquitted for want of evidence. Shelvocke nevertheless went on to re-establish his reputation and died at the age of 67 years.

Frank himself has never sailed a 'voyage 'round the world,' he has never been brought up on charges of piracy, and he has never knowledgeably inspired any famous poetry... but it is true that he HAS:

- •Set foot on five of the seven continents, working laboriously on four of those five.
- •Swam in three of the five World Oceans.
- •Eaten a sandwich whilst sitting on both the southern and northern hemispheres... simultaneously! Astounding.
